STEYNING DOWNLAND SCHEME

Memorial Benches

- 1. A request to place a Memorial Bench (with or without a Plaque) or to place a Plaque on an existing Bench shall be made in writing or e-mail to the Project Manager [contact details]
- 2. It is expected that the applicant can show a specific connection with the SDS in respect of the person in whose memory the Bench or Plaque is requested
- 3. It shall be at the discretion of the Project Manager as to whether or not to accede to a request, taking into account:
 - 1. The views of the SDS Steering Group and, if appropriate, the Trustees, on a particular request; and
 - 2. Whether the location of the proposed Bench is at a location previously identified by the SDS as being available for the placing of a Bench; and
 - The number of Benches already in place on the Steyning Downland Scheme
 - 4. i) In return to acceding to a request for a Bench the applicant will be expected to make a donation to the SDS
 - ii) The amount of the donation will be agreed between the applicant and the Project Manager but as a general guide the SDS would expect it to be at least £550
- 5. i) The Bench will be rustic in style and constructed by the SDS Conservation Volunteers
- ii) They will endeavour to construct it as soon as reasonably practicable but the SDS cannot promise to complete it by a specified date.

- iii) SDS gives no assurances as to maintaining the Bench or as to its longevity, and has no responsibility or liability in such respects
- iv) The SDS reserves the right to replace a Bench which clearly, or the SDS deems, has weathered to a poor state of repair, or is otherwise damaged, with a new Bench
- 6. i) If agreed by the SDS, a Plaque may be affixed to an existing Bench provided that the Bench and Plaque are in memory of the same person
- ii) The text used on a Plaque, whether on an existing Bench or otherwise, will be agreed by the Project Manager, in consultation with the SDS Trustees
- 7. If the applicant is unhappy with any decision of the Project Manager, he or she will be entitled to raise it with the Chairman of Trustees [Richard Goring, Wiston Estate Office, Wiston Park, West Sussex, BN44 3DD. Tel. 01903 812129], whose decision shall be final
- 8. This Memorial Bench Policy will be reviewed by the SDS from time to time, and at least annually
